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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WESCOTT FARMS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

A Nonprofit Corporation

The undersigned, being over the age of eighteen (18) years, acting as incorporator for the purposes of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina as contained in Chapter 55A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT" and the several amendments thereto, does hereby set forth:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation is: Wescott Farms Homeowners Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II Duration

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III Purpose

This Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for the maintenance, management, operation and preservation of that certain property known as Wescott Farms, shown on described on the plat recorded or to be recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Brunswick County, North Carolina, and any additions thereto which may be brought within the jurisdiction of the Corporation; and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the members, and to exercise those powers hereinafter set forth.

ARTICLE IV Membership

The Corporation shall have members as provided in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE V Election of Directors

Directors of the corporation shall be designated in the manner provided by the By-Laws.

No amendment or repeal of this article, nor the adoption of any provision of these Articles of Incorporation inconsistent with this article, shall eliminate or reduce the protection granted herein with respect to any matter that occurred prior to such amendment, repeal or adoption.

ARTICLE XII Effective Date

These articles shall be effective upon filing.
